20/21-hour recommendation

For these groups, we have put together our Accountant’s Update Programme (UK Practice). Enrol from February.

- Chartered Accountants Ireland members and those previously members of CPA Ireland must complete a minimum of 20 hours of structured CPD every year.

For Irish accountants in practice, we have put together the Accountant’s Update Programme (Ireland). Enrol from February.

An AccountingCPD licence enables you to tailor the programme to meet your personal needs.

Members in audit roles should add in 4 hours of audit updates, to replace content that is less relevant to them. You may also wish to substitute 4 hours of IFRS updates for 4 hours of UK updates, depending on the requirements of your clients.

SUGGESTED CPD PATHWAYS

For Accountants in Business

20/21-hour recommendation

- ACCA members in business must complete at least 21 hours of verifiable CPD.
- ICAEW members in business Category 1 must complete at least 15 hours of verifiable CPD.

For these groups, we have put together the Accountant's Update Programme (UK Business). This can be tailored to meet your personal needs. An AccountingCPD licence gives you complete flexibility.

If you work in a larger company, you might prefer the Accountant's Update Programme (International), which has greater focus of IFRS.

- Chartered Accountants Ireland members and those previously members of CPA Ireland must complete a minimum of 20 hours of structured CPD every year.

For Irish accountants in practice, we have put together the Accountant's Update Programme (Ireland). Enrol from February.

30-hour recommendation

- ICAEW members in Category 1 must complete at least 30 hours of verifiable CPD.

For ICAEW members who work in business, we recommend completing the Accountant's Update Programme (UK Business), or the Accountant's Update Programme (International).

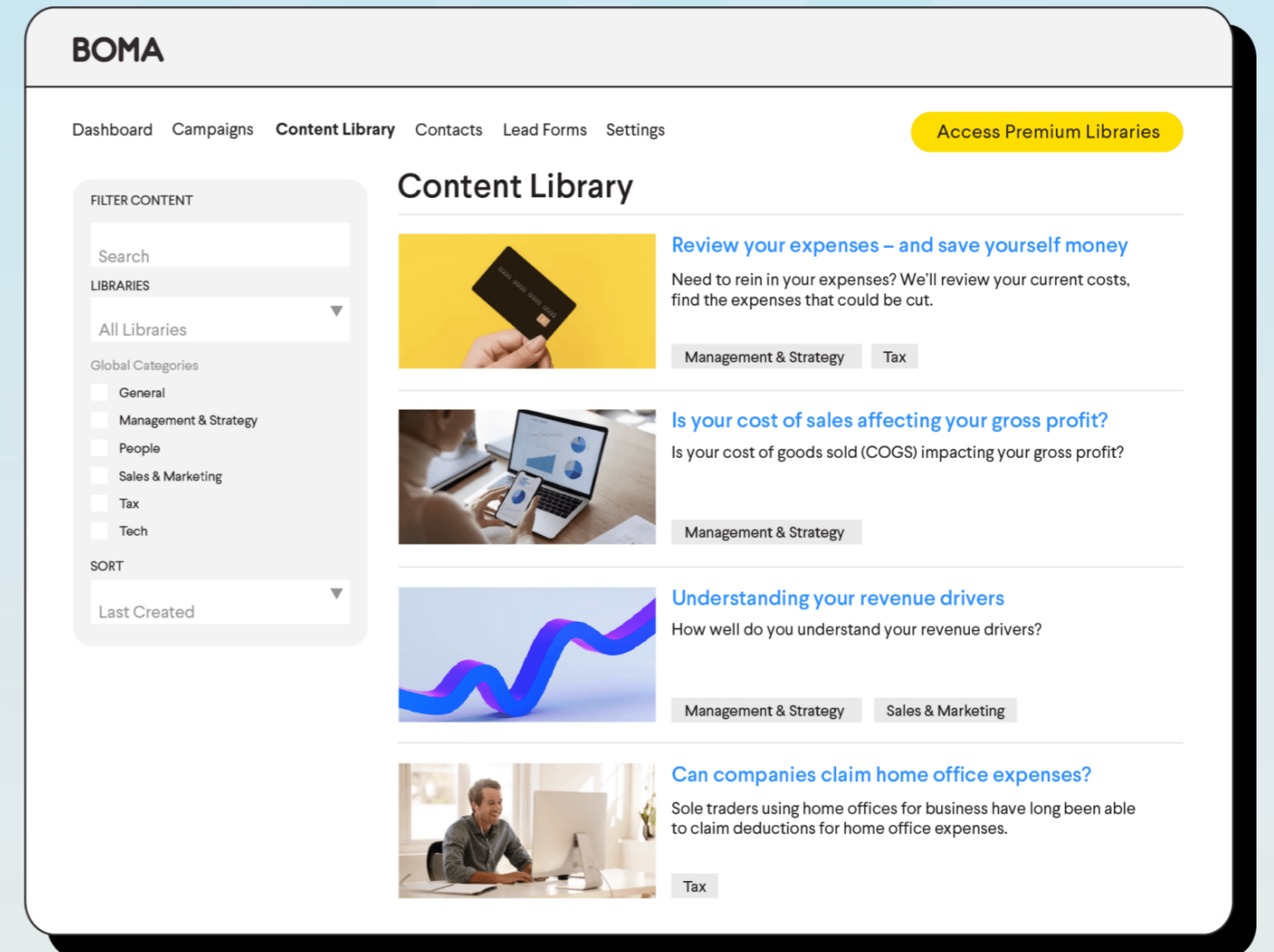
